Introduction

All people who work for NT Christian Schools are expected to have a clear understanding of, and unqualified commitment to the biblical basis, *'What We Believe'*, and to act both in the work place and in other contexts in ways that are consistent with that basis.

With a mutual commitment to God through Jesus Christ, staff members ought to serve and love one another as Christ loves them. This also means an acknowledgement that all people are fallible and need to be entirely reliant upon God. The organisation has expectations of mutual love, service, trust, acceptance, patience, forgiveness and support.

General Expectations:

Your work for the organisation involves serving and supporting those people for whom we exist, namely students and their parents. This is the core function for all people employed by NT Christian Schools. Each is expected to work as a member of a team serving and supporting each other in the various tasks to which God has called them. Each team member is expected to contribute positively to the maintenance of a pleasant, purposeful, productive and safe workplace.

These responsibilities and duties are, therefore, underpinned by expectations of generosity, openness, teamwork, effectiveness, efficiency, attention to detail, pleasant working relationships and maintenance of an effective, attractive, safe work environment.

Parameters for this position

The central role of the Instrumental Music Tutor is to inspire and guide students through the study, practice and performance of music by creating an environment of active and genuine learning. Tutors may meet with students on a one-on-one basis or in small groups.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Teach your instrument(s) to either individuals or small groups.
- Monitor each student's progress and keep the student and parents informed of progress through the use of a music practice journal and other communication methods.
- Keep accurate records of achievement and attendance in order to provide an end of term report.
- Prepare your instrumental students to perform at the end of Semester concert.

Selection criteria

- Be a committed Christian actively involved in your local church.
- Have appropriate music qualifications. A tertiary qualification is desirable but not essential.
- Be pastorally committed to the task of caring for and nurturing students.
- Be willing and able to attend to the Administration tasks required for this position.
- Write a report for each student at the end of each semester.
